Dear Healthcare Professional,

In mid-2021, Medtronic issued a Medical Device Correction for LINQ II[™] Insertable Cardiac Monitors (ICMs); the two communications (dated June 2021 and August 2021) of this advisory are enclosed. This letter provides supplemental information to that advisory.

The June 2021 advisory notified customers of the potential for LINQ II ICMs that had experienced a partial electrical reset that disabled Brady, Pause, and PVC event detection and reporting to clinicians. In the event that Medtronic's data indicated specific devices that had experienced a partial electrical reset, clinicians received a supplemental letter with the details of those devices.

Since June 2021, Medtronic has implemented continuous monitoring of all CareLink™ enrolled LINQ II patients for partial electrical resets as an assist to clinicians' efforts to identify affected devices. As of <date>, we have identified one or more LINQ II devices associated with your hospital/clinic that have experienced a partial electrical reset and that are no longer detecting Brady, Pause, and PVC events as designed:
